Major Indian Exports to Baden-Württemberg		The top significant Indian exports to Baden-Württemberg encompass a diverse range of products, including automotive components, pharmaceutical products, metal goods, cotton apparel (knitted or crocheted), leather products, jewellery (gold and silver), intermediate chemicals, electronic devices, machinery and technical equipment, and footwear.
Major Imports of India from Baden-Württemberg		The major items of import are automotive components, followed by machinery and apparatus for power generation and distribution. Other significant import goods include machines for paper production and printing, as well as for textile and leather production. Machine tools and chemical end products are also among the top imports. Motor vehicles and motor vehicle parts, including chassis, bodies, and engines, are also significant import goods. Electrical and electronic equipment, as well as optical, photographic, technical, and medical apparatus, are among the important imports of India from this region.
