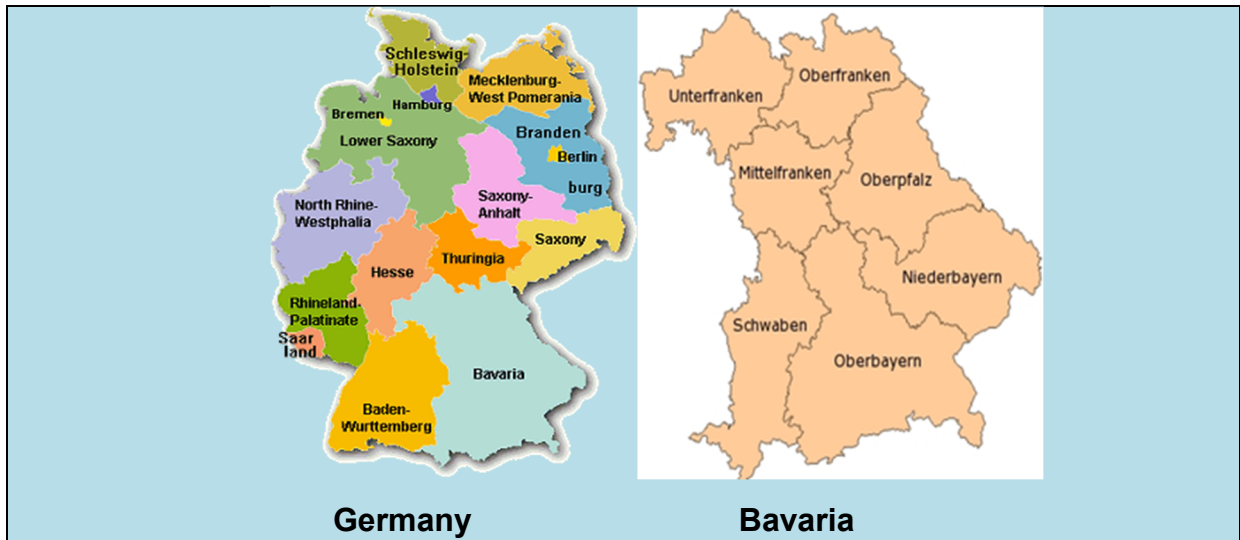

<p>Indian investments in Bavaria</p>	<p>Bavaria is keen to project their State as a preferred destination for potential Indian investments. For this, they have opened a representative office of Invest-in-Bavaria in Bengaluru in 2001 which has been upgraded to a full representative office in 2013. Their main Chambers of Commerce and Industry remain actively involved in promoting business awareness through seminars, roundtables, and sector-specific presentations. At present, some 80 Indian companies have invested in Bavaria and includes companies like: TCS, Wipro, L&T Infotech, Infosys Ltd, Dr. Reddy's Lab, Aurobindo Pharma, Graphite India, etc.</p>
<p>Bavarian investments in India</p>	<p>Bavaria-based companies have traditionally considered India as a reliable and promising economic partner. At present, some 350 Bavarian companies have their business ventures in India in different fields. Some of the big names include Siemens, BMW, Audi, MAN, Adidas, Allianz AG, Munich Re, Airbus, Infineon, Wacker Chemie, Osram, Linde, etc. Nearly 1,500 Bavarian companies maintain business relationships with India.</p>
<p>Indian Community</p>	<p>51,820 (approx.) According to official figures, Bavaria is home to around 41,619 Indian nationals including 10,201 Indian students. In addition, there are an estimated 10,000 Germans of Indian origin in Bavaria. The Indian Diaspora in Bavaria includes IT professionals, businessmen and traders, restaurant owners, students and researchers.
