Consulate General of India (CGI), Munich has been organizing consular camps in various cities across the states of Bayern and Baden-Wurttemberg in its efforts to reach out to Indian community & diaspora and to encourage and guide them in organizing various events to commemorate Amrit Mahotsav and to celebrate 75<sup>th</sup> year of India's independence.

Consular camps provide opportunities for personal submission of application forms for various consular services directly to Consular Officers. It also provides opportunities to seek guidance on various consular matters as well as personal interaction on various issues. 12 such consular camps were organized in several cities like Stuttgart, Ulm, Nuremberg, Baden-Baden, Mannheim, Augsburg etc. in 2021.

It may be noted that fee in cash is not acceptable at the consular camps and applicants are advised to transfer the requisite fee in the bank account of the Consular directly beforehand and attach a proof of payment/transfer of fee with their applications.
